# *Introduction*

This documentation tries to describe a behavior CSS styles of Annotation editor in StorySpace. You should have elementary knowledge of CSS styles.

# Theme.css

## Dialog

Dialog is a general class for windows. Subclasses begin with *.aed-ui-dlg-...*

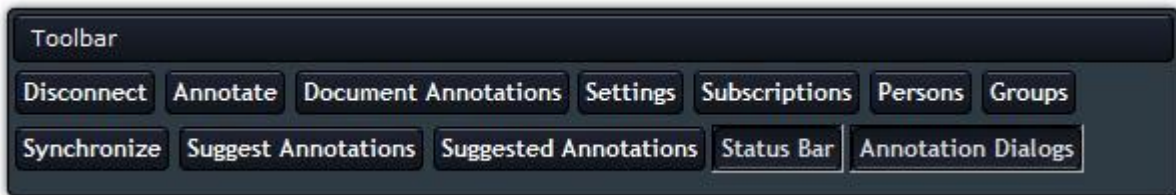


Figure 1: Screenshot of dialog window:

The dialog has these classes:

*.aed-ui-dlg* - Sets up padding, font size and type and overflow on hidden. Hidden means, that there will be no scroll bar on the right side of the dialog window.

*.aed-ui-dlg-header* - Sets up relative position, which means the element is positioned relative to its normal position, so "left:20" adds 20 pixels to the element's LEFT position, next it is display, padding, where a top and a bottom have a length 0.1em and a right and a left side have the length same as the top and the bottom. This header has sets up background, border and color for font.

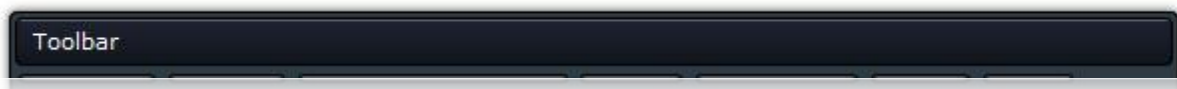


Figure 2: The *.aed-ui-dlg-header* class of dialog window

There is the class *.aed-ui-dlg-header* in figure 2.

There were used to classes *.aed-ui-dlg-titlebar* and *.aed-ui-dlg-title* in the figure 2. The class *.aed-ui-dlg-titlebar* takes care of display and of position. The class *.aed-ui-dlg-title* takes care of color and of size for font and sets up padding for the left side on length 0.4em.

The classes *.aed-ui-draggable* and *.aed-ui-dlg-titlebar* change cursor to drag icon.

## Buttons

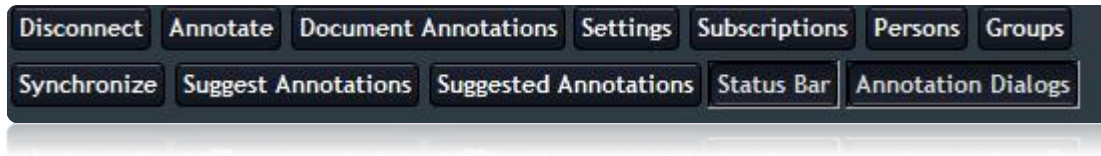


Figure 3: The buttons of dialog window

Main class is an *.aed-ui-btn* class. The class takes care of button. Buttons you can see in figure 3. The *aed-ui-btn* class sets up font type, font size, text align, font weight, background and background position. Main class *aed-ui-btn* sets up the element, which is placed as an inline element (on the same line as adjacent content), but it behaves as a block element. Next it is right margin, overflow, padding, position and the others. There is the cursor render as a pointer.

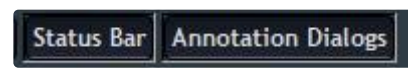


Figure 5: Selected buttons of dialog window

There are classes, which take care of styles, which begin after selected and hovered on button. It means what will be font color or background in button. This makes *.aed-ui-btn-selected* class and *.aed-ui-btn-hover* class. The *.aed-ui-btn-selected* class selects (figure 5) a button and the *.aed-ui-btn-hover* makes hover via button (figure 4).

There is class ***.aed-ui-btn-disabled***, which sets up the default cursor, font color and background color and background image. The class disables cursor.

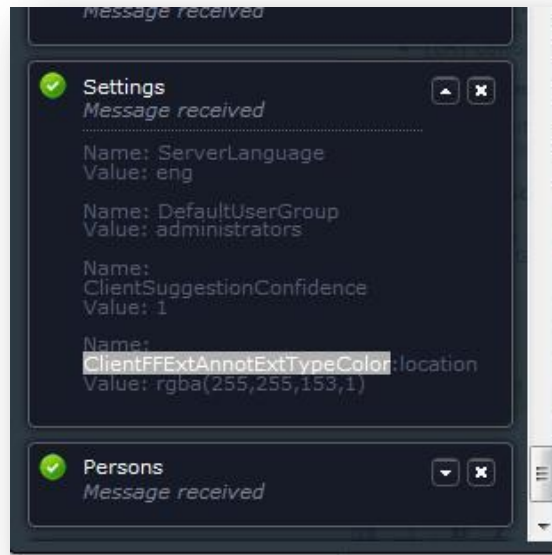


Figure 6: Used to ***.aed-ui-msg-buttons*** and ***.aed-ui-btn*** classes of dialog window

Classes ***.aed-ui-dlg-header-buttons*** and ***.aed-ui-btn*** together set up height, margin, padding for top, bottom, right and left side and border as solid. There is class ***.aed-ui-msg-buttons*** together ***.aed-ui-btn***. These classes set up same styles as preview classes. These used classes you can see in figure 6.

In figure 6 you can find these classes:

The dialog subsumes next classes:

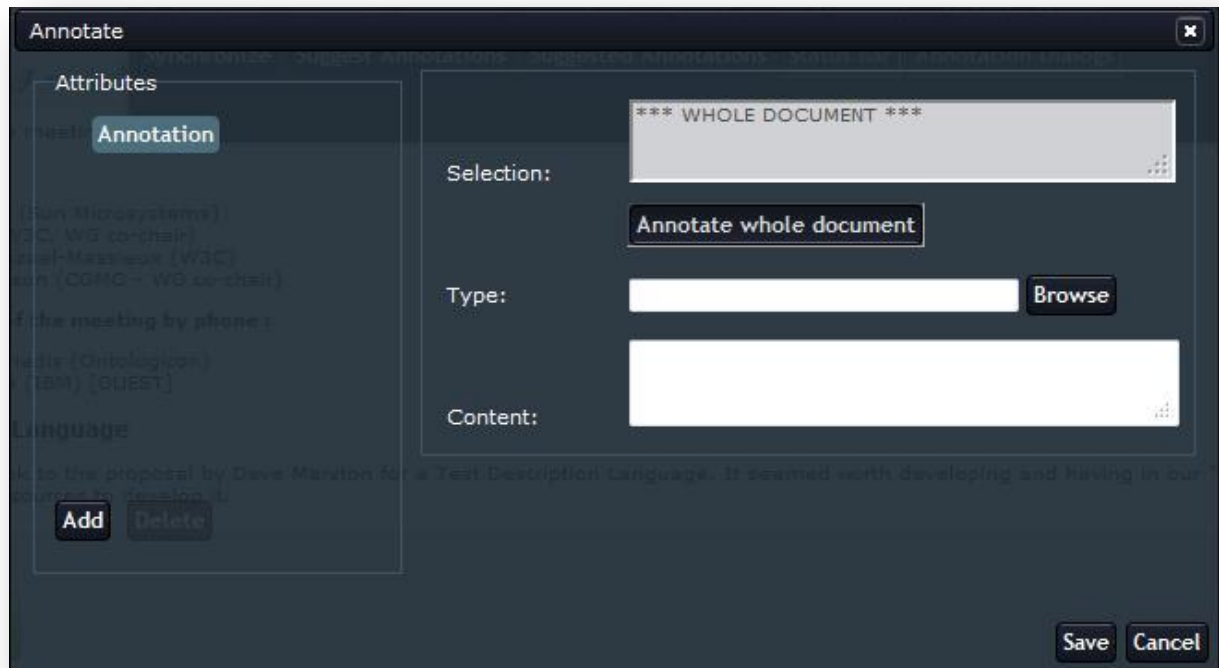


Figure 8: Used to .aed-ui-dlg-content class of dialog window

The ***.aed-ui-overlay*** class sets up width, height and background. This class makes overlay. The ***.aed-ui-dlg-content*** class (in figure 8) sets up width, height and overflow-y as auto. It'll be should cause a scrolling mechanism to be provided for overflowing boxes.

## Iframe dialog

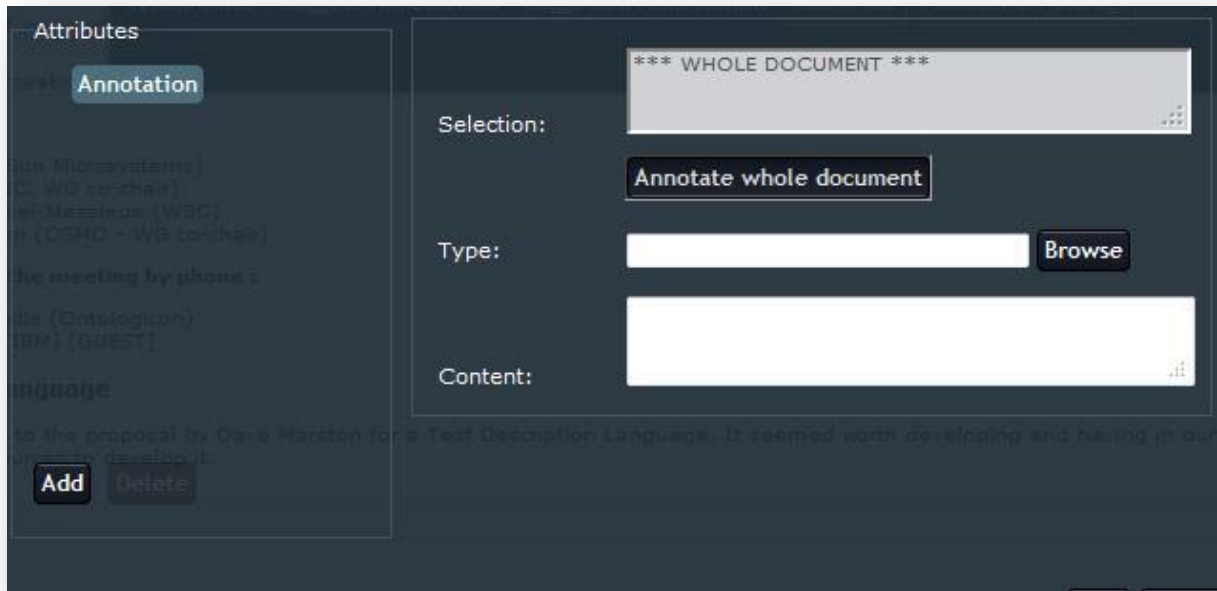


Figure 9: The iframe of dialog window

This general class you find in figure 9. The dialog is an iframe.

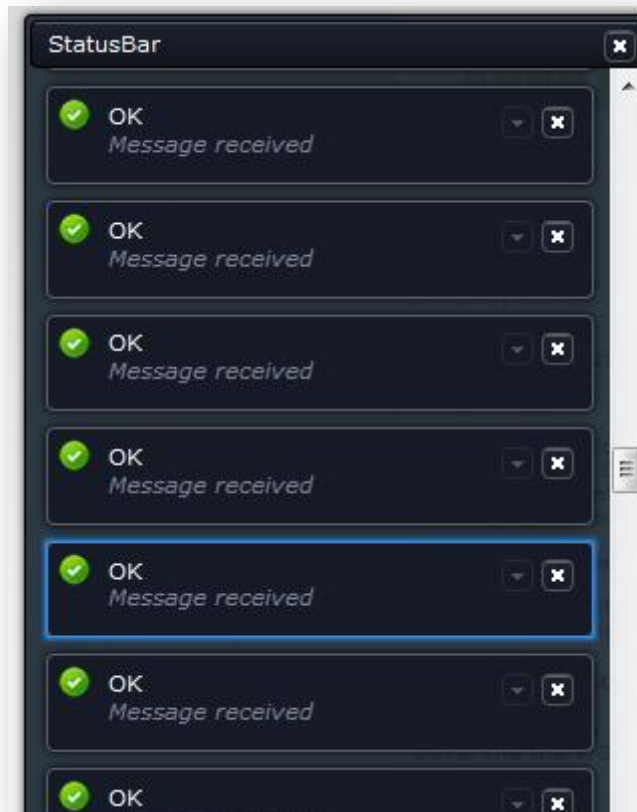


Figure 10: The statusBar with icons of dialog window

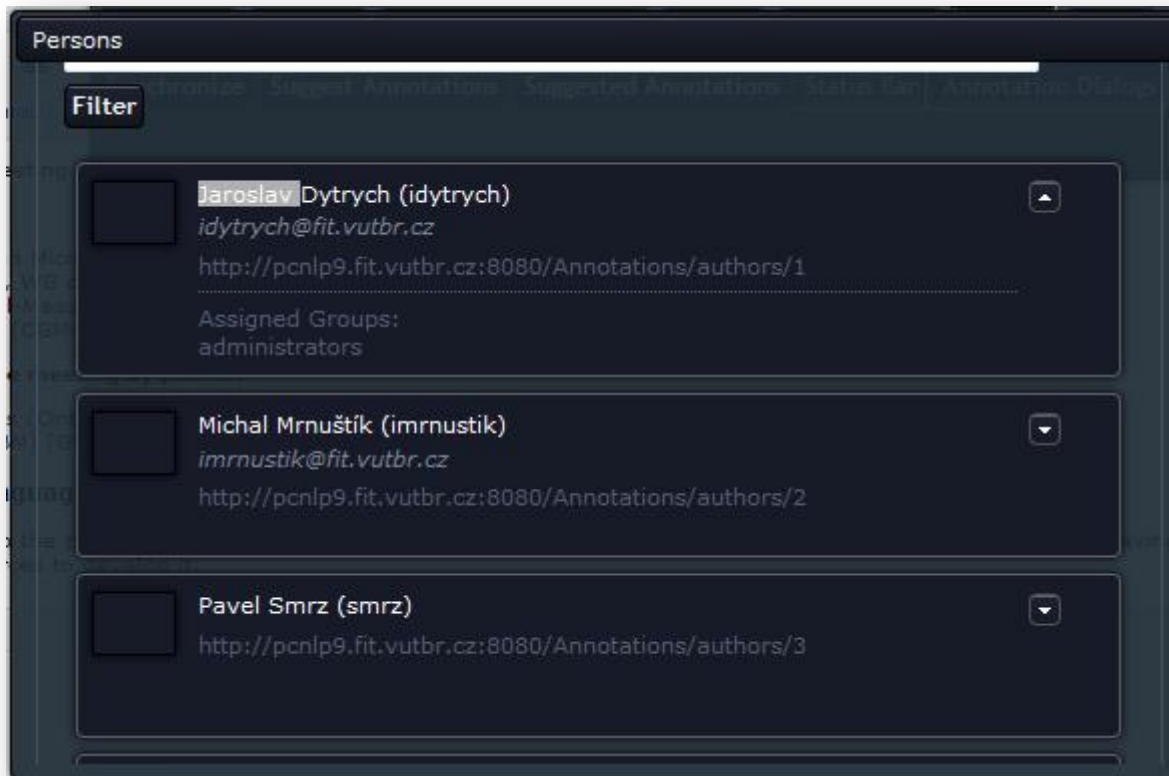


Figure 12: General class Person of dialog window

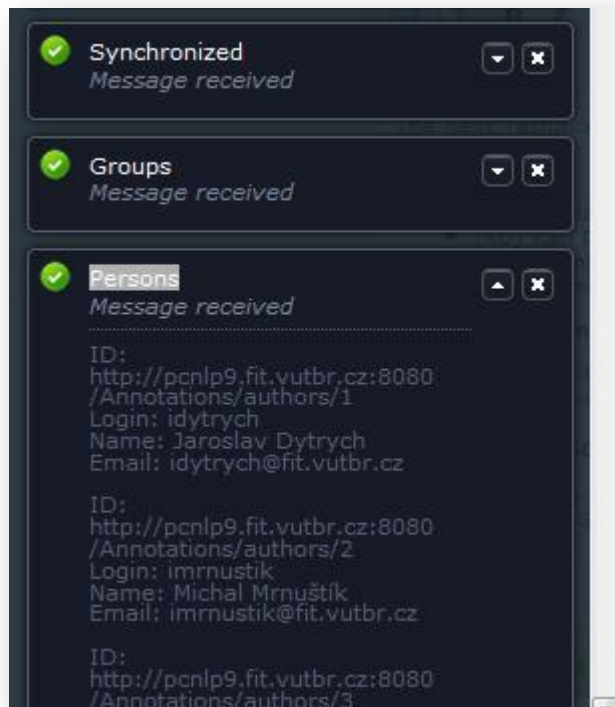


Figure 14: The general class Message in the statusBar of dialog window

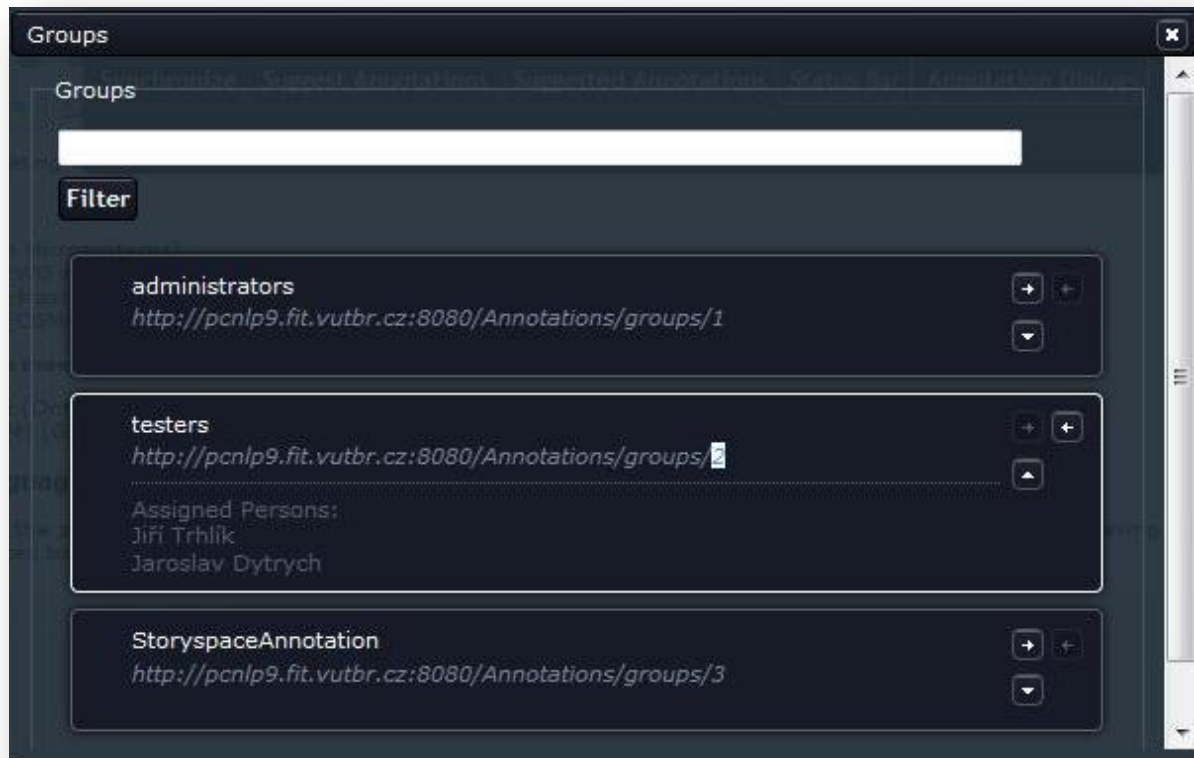


Figure 16: The general class Group of dialog window

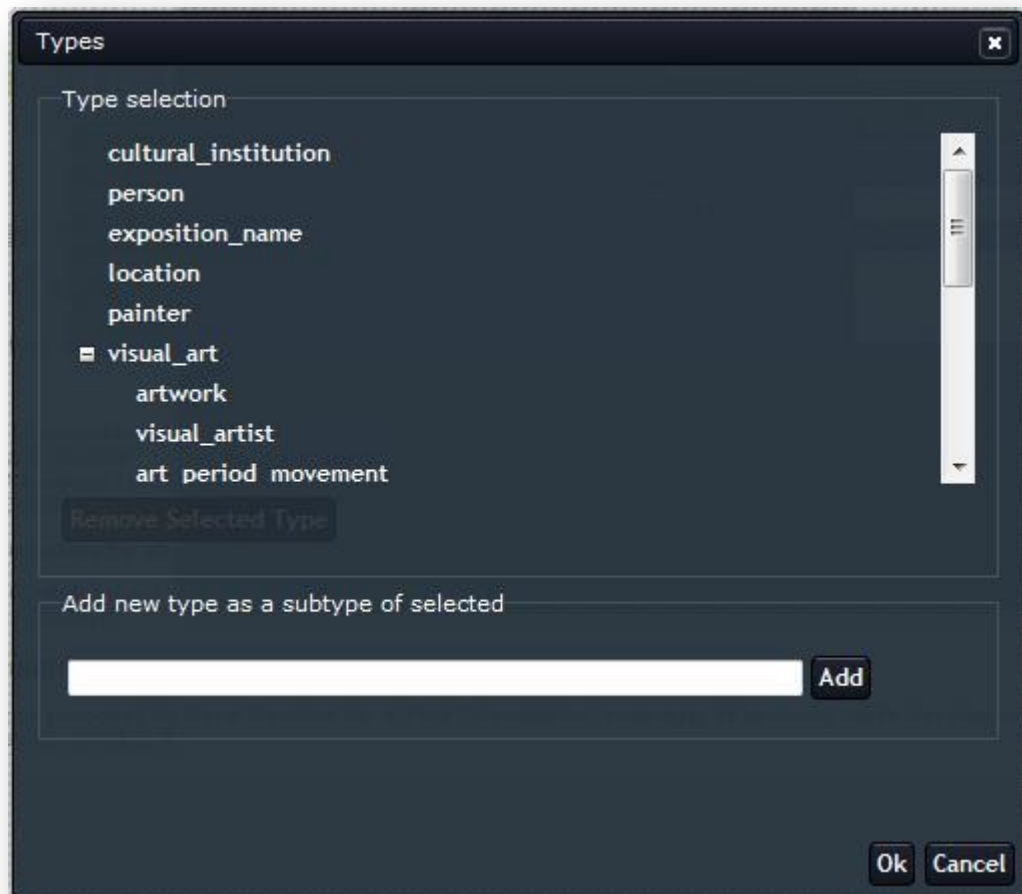


Figure 17: The tree of dialog window

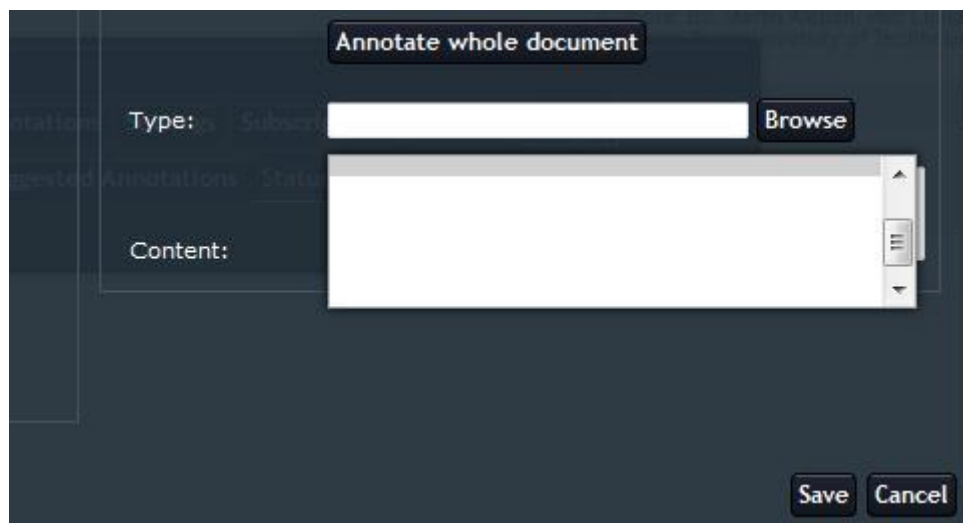

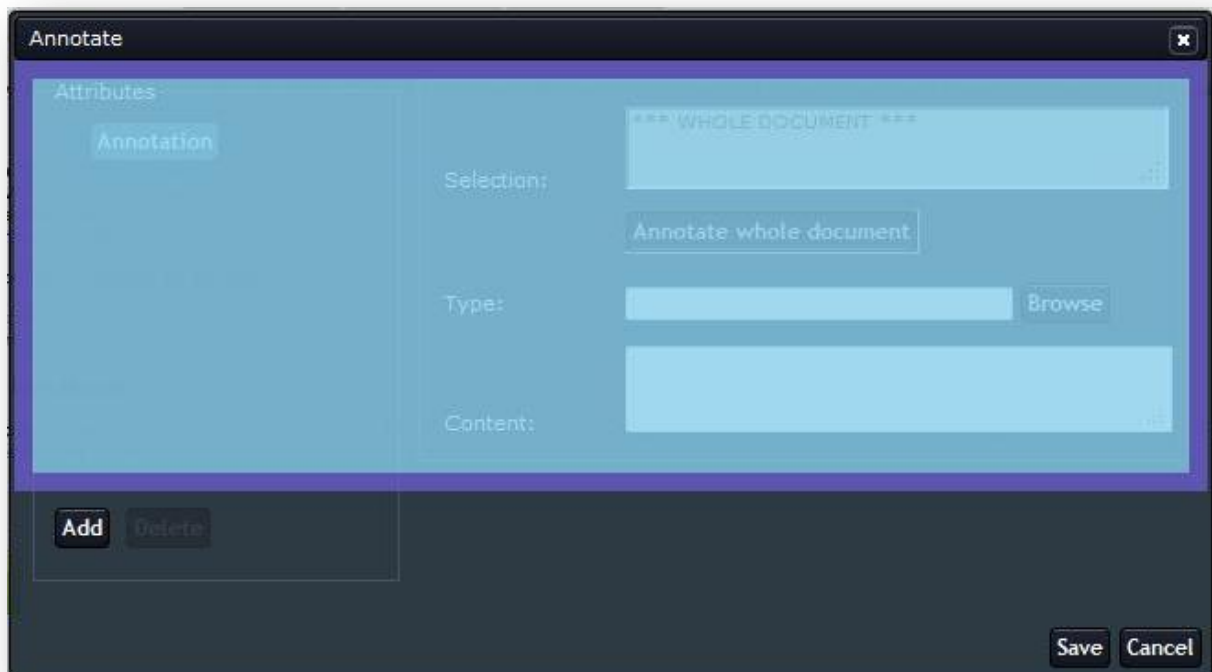
## *Eric Mayer's Reset CSS styles*

Eric Mayer – he pioneered the technique of CSS Reset.

The reset styles given here are intentionally very generic. There isn't any default color or background set for the body element, for example. It should be edited, extended, tweaked and otherwise tuned to match your specific reset baseline.

The goal of a reset stylesheet is to reduce browser inconsistencies in things like default line heights, margins and font sizes of headings, and so on.



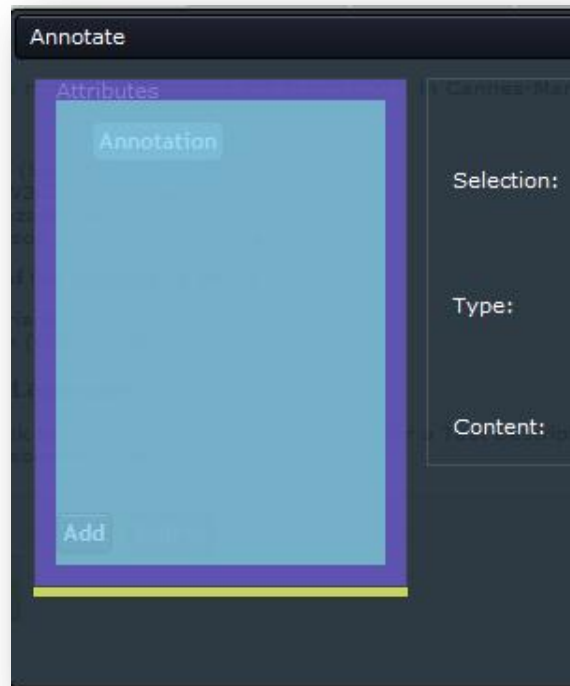

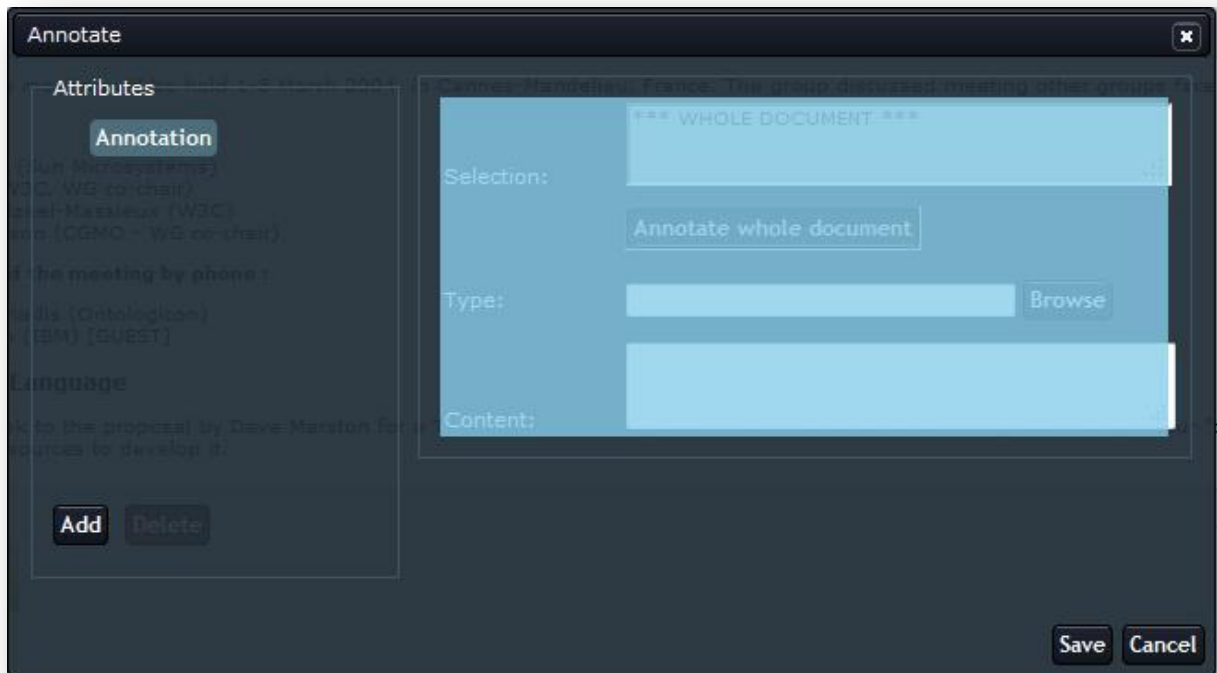


Figure 22: The table of dialog window

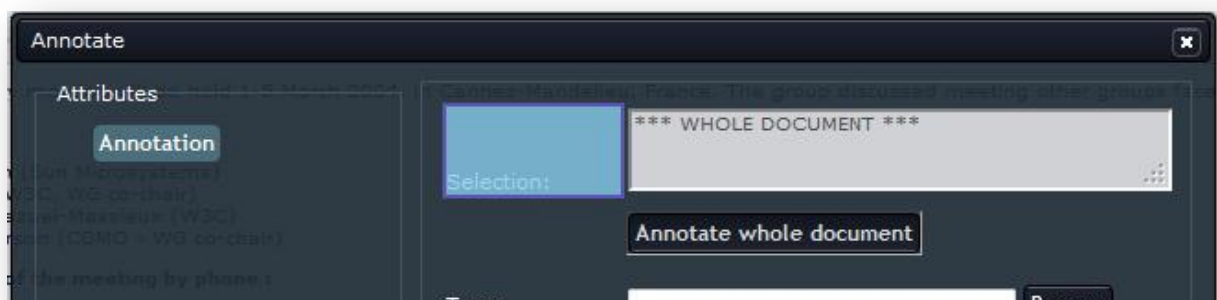


Figure 23: The table's column of dialog window

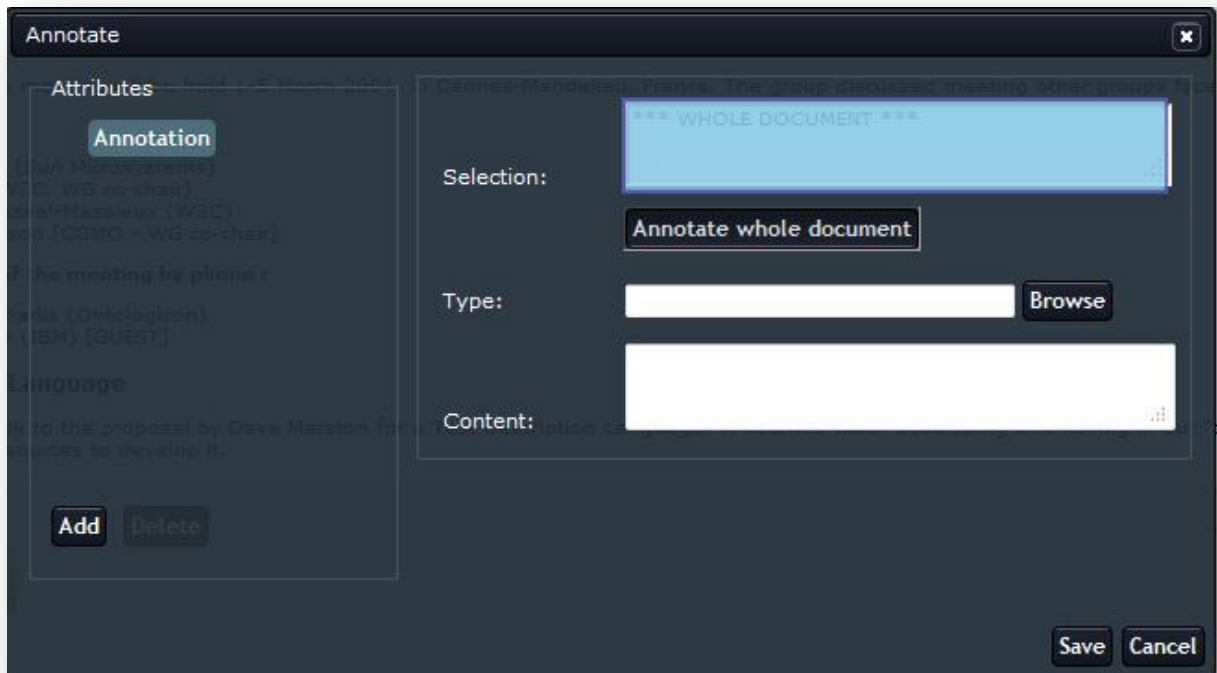


Figure 24: The table cell of dialog window

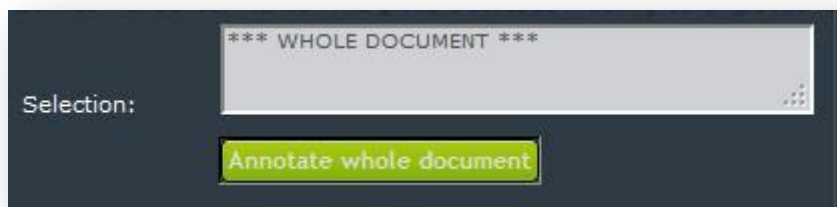


Figure 25: Input and select of dialog window

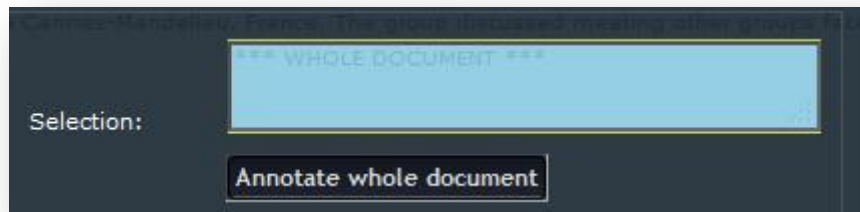


Figure 26: The textarea of dialog window

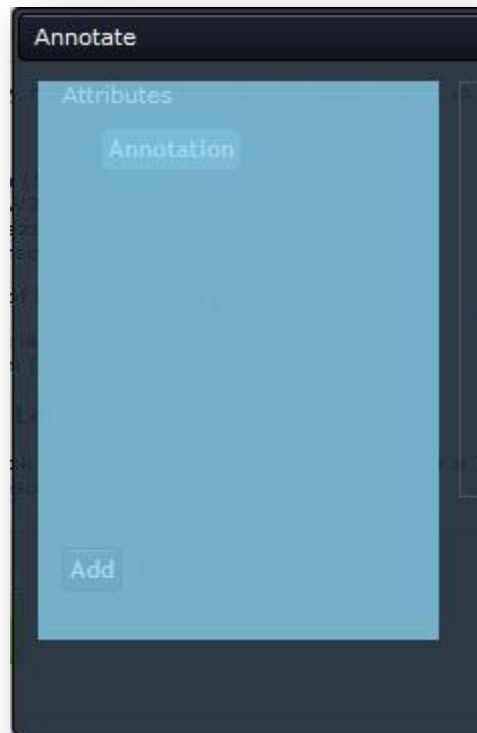

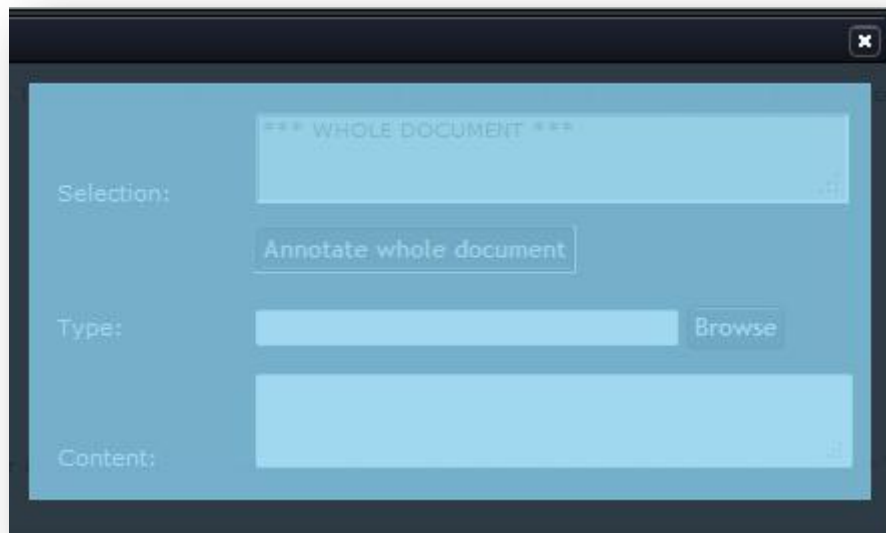

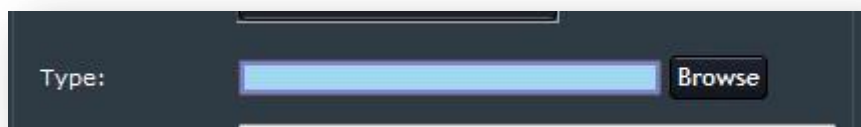
*Figure 27: The left annotate of dialog window*

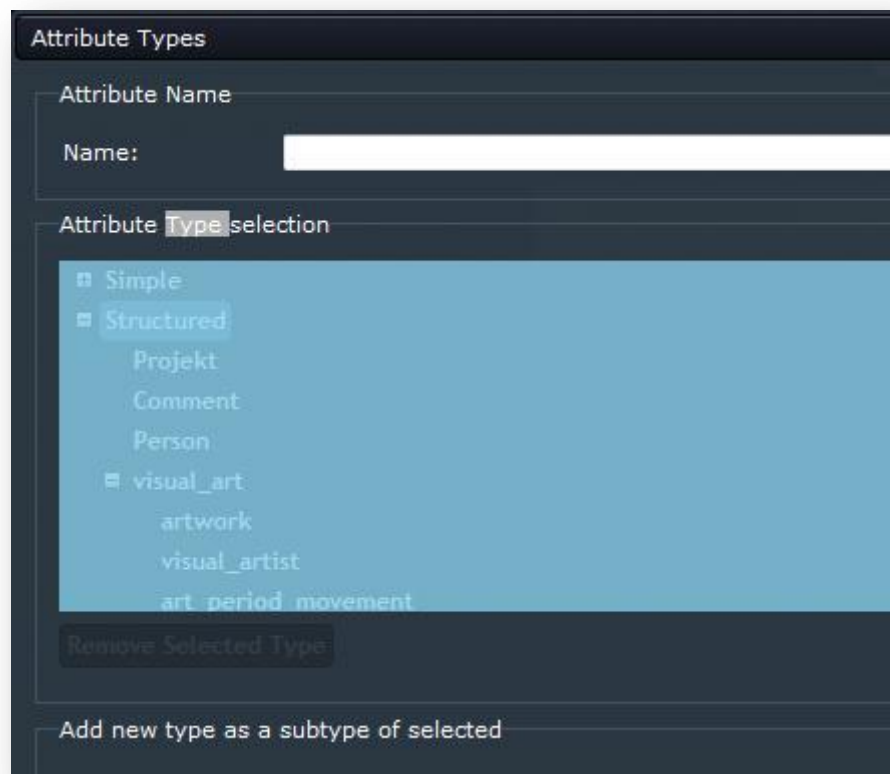
*Figure 28: The right annotate of dialog window*

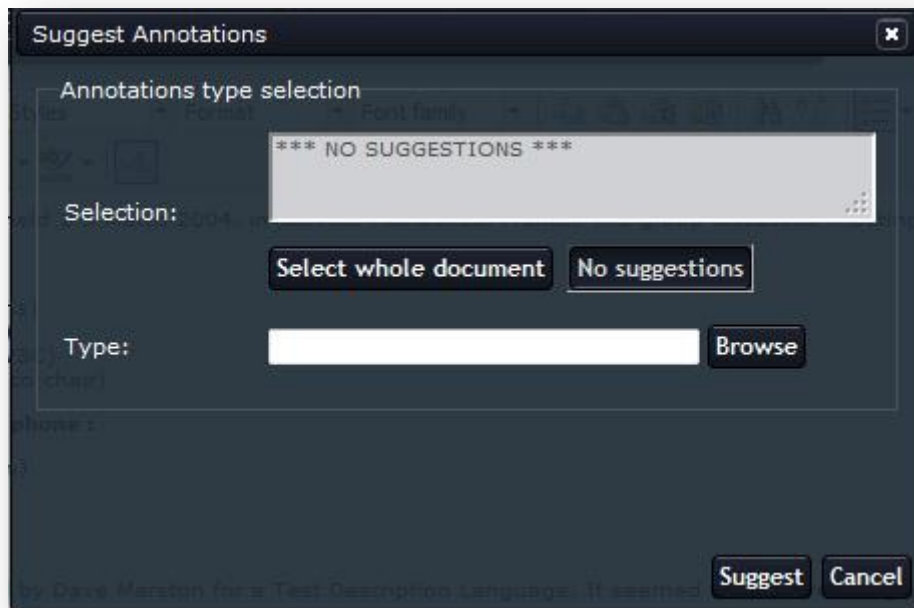


Figure 31: The suggest annotation of dialog window

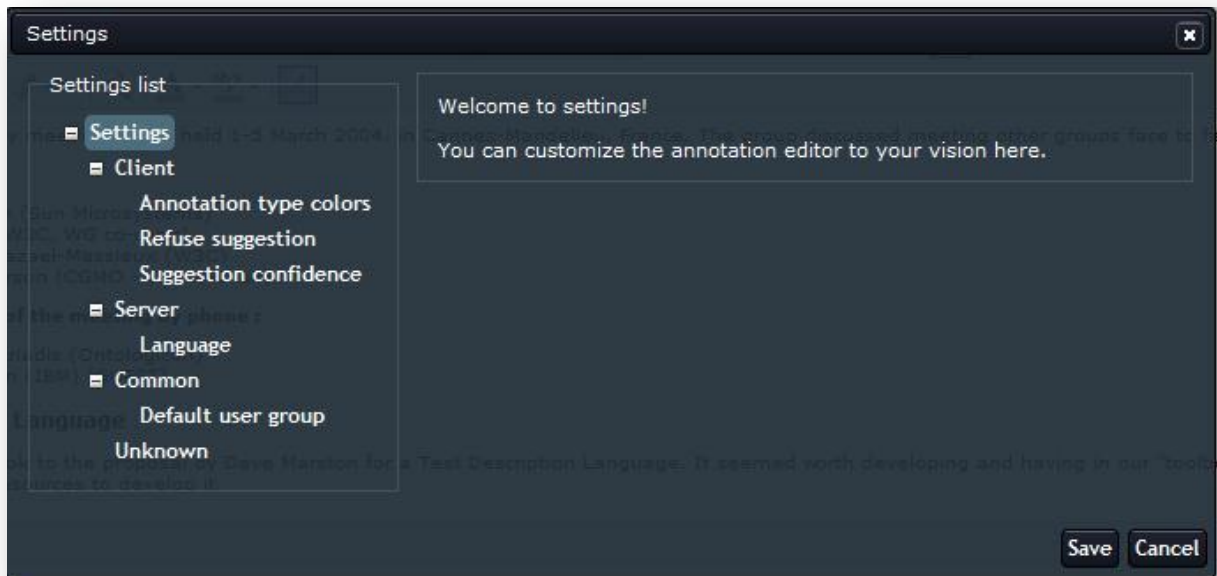


Figure 32: The dialog Settings of dialog window

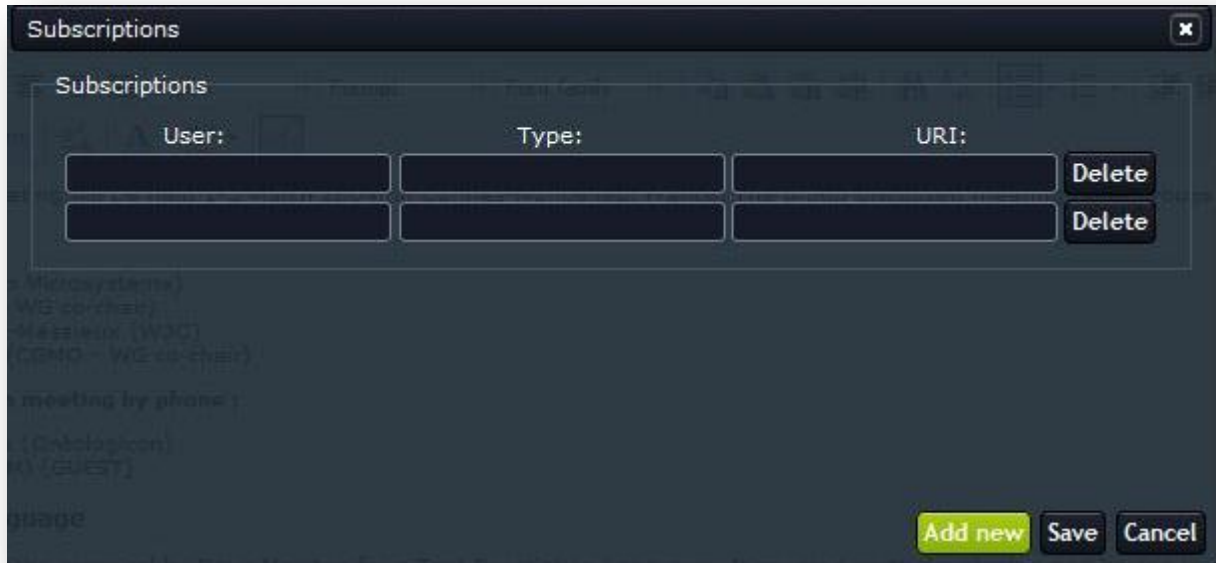


Figure 33: The dialog Subscriptions of dialog window

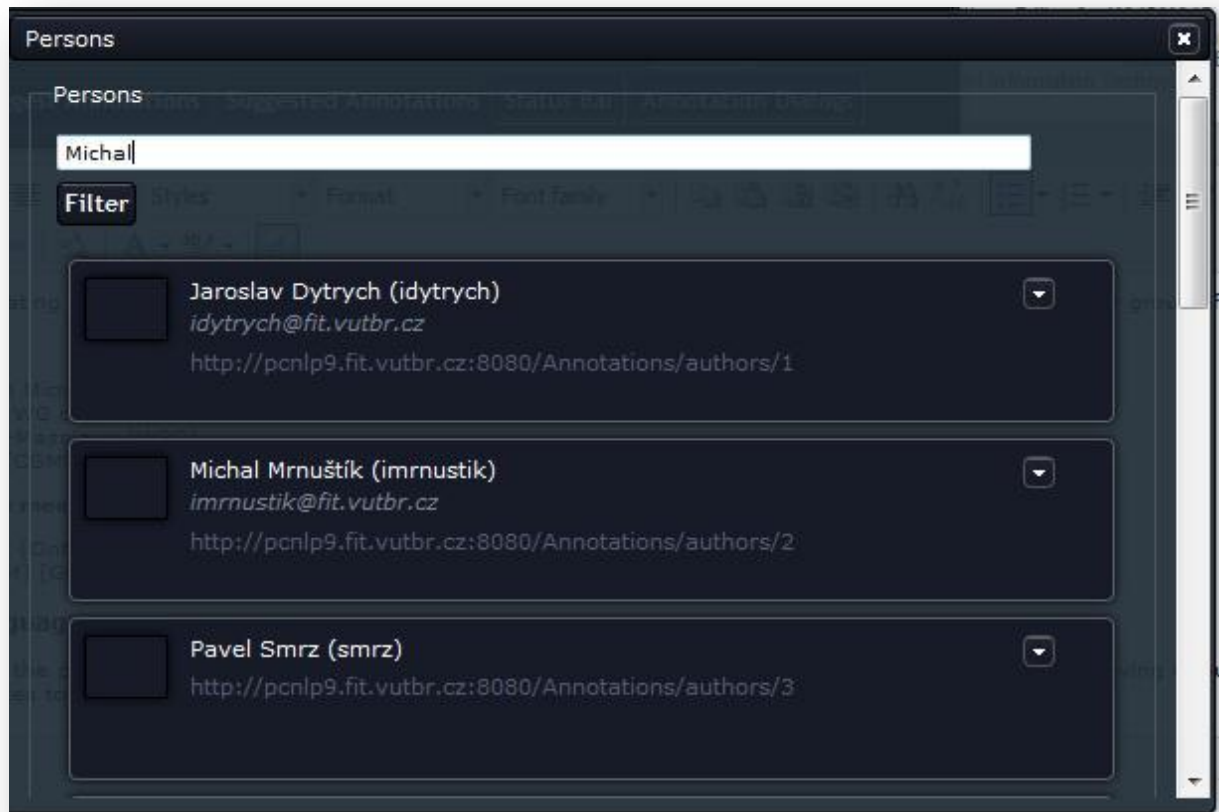
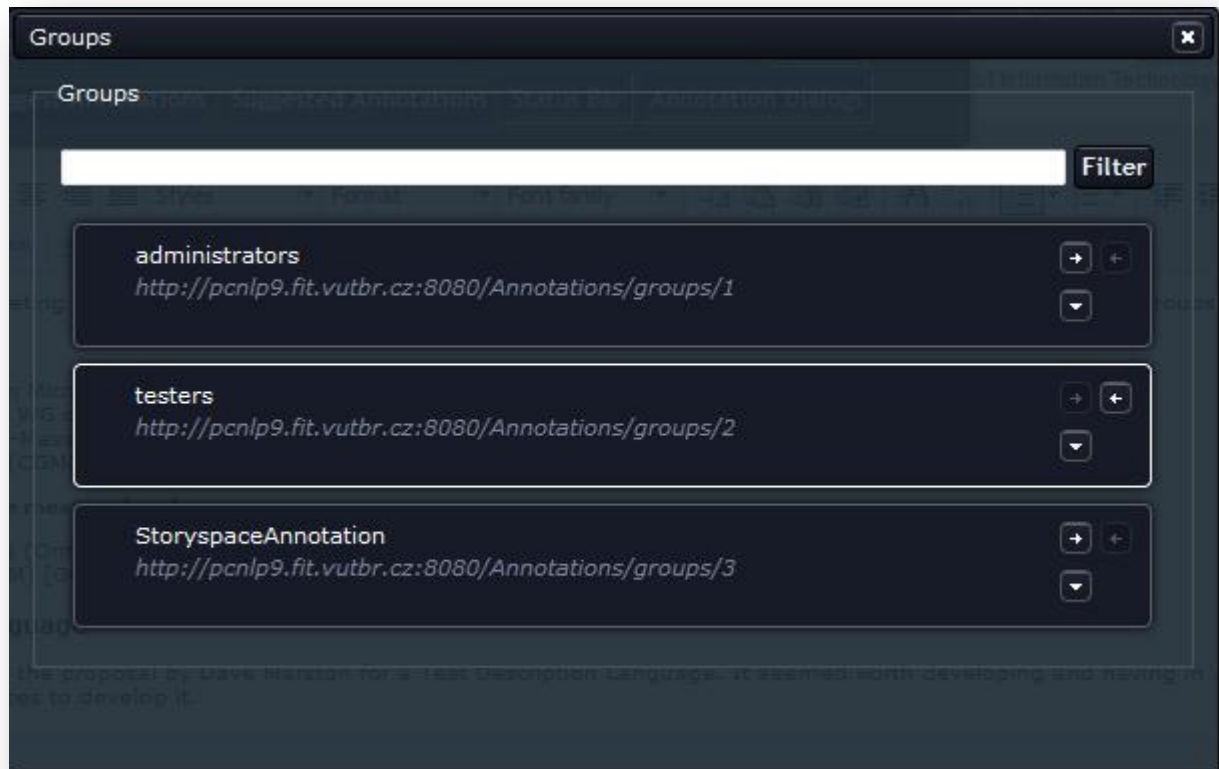


Figure 34: The dialog Persons of dialog window
